### Recommended credit

3 – 4 U.S. semester credits per Canterbury course

\*A “C-“is a restricted credit, which is the equivalent to pass for credit purposes, but it cannot be used as a prerequisite.

Typically, a full-time load consists of 60 points. The minimum load is 45 points and the maximum is 80 points, with students taking 3 - 4 individual semester-long courses.
