Recommended credit

1 subject at the AUT University = 3 - 4 US semester credits

One paper (class) is typically 15 points.

Semester credit point load = Minimum of 60 credit points (typically 4 subjects) to be considered full time
Total credit point load to earn a degree = 360 points
